Results	 94 subjects were directly involved (about 3000 people of which at least 1500 young people and about 60% men and 40% women), indirectly involving over 500,000 people in the population of the district of Tuzla The study on the biodiversity of the Konjuh Protected Landscape was carried out. The study generated a biological collection of 911 samples and contributed to the identification of 461 species and subspecies of flora and defined the main types of vegetation (forest and secondary grasslands) and the habitat of the Konjuh protected landscape. A community map was produced that includes sites of natural, cultural and historical interest, ecosystems and tourist services. Over 90 meetings, over 20 seminars and workshops were organized to which over 300 people participated. The collaboration of 26 civil society organizations, representatives of 20 administrative division's institutions and local authorities, 10 schools, 1 university and around 10 private actors made it possible to identify and organize 8 tourist packages of which 4 have been tested and are ready to be put on the market. 23 guided tours, 14 didactic and educational events and 11 recreational activities and 52 awareness and information events were organized
