Action to enhance the integrated water systems in Albania

The project aims to improve the institutional and governance capacities of the City of Vlora, in line with the City to City Cooperation program between Milan and Vlora, ensuring 100% of citizens have **access to proper wastewater treatment** (from 80,000 to 160,000), **improving the distribution network** by 15 km (17,456 inhabitants with stable access to running water) and **increasing the areas subject to environmental controls** by over 395 km².

EXPECTED RESULTS

1. The wastewater treatment and control systems for illegal discharges in the urban, peri-urban, and rural areas of the Municipality of Vlora have been modernized and made more efficient.
2. The water distribution system of the Municipality of Vlora has been extended to the rural area of Zvernec, digitized, and made more efficient.
3. Cooperation between public institutions, businesses, and the population for the sustainable management of water resources and the reduction of pollution in watersheds has been strengthened.
