



Protecting local livestock breeds and promoting their products in disadvantaged areas of Bosnia and Herzegovina

The project aims at improving the capacity of public entities, breeders, farmers, and agri-food producers in Bosnia and Herzegovina to **adopt EU standards, policies, and practices related to the protection of local animal breeds** and increase the value of their products.

EXPECTED RESULTS

1. **An inventory of local breeds and genetic resources is created**, in parallel to capacity building for local government and research officials to support the sector's development and alignment with the EU acquis;
2. **Guidelines for sustainable production are developed and implemented** in the project's pilot areas to improve livestock health and animal welfare;
3. **Promotion of traditional products** derived from indigenous breeds and assessment of their environmental impact;
4. **New agritourism businesses are established**, encouraging income diversification for local stakeholders and the creation of value-added products.
