Alliance for the Development of Early Childhood Education in Kosovo

This project is the second phase of an action promoted by RTM - Volunteers in the World in support of the Ministry of Education of Kosovo (MES) to **strengthen the early childhood education system (0-6 years)**, in line with the Kosovo National Strategy for Education and with the Sustainable Development Goal N. 4, "Inclusive and Quality education for all".

The project aims at consolidating the positive results of the first phase and contributing to tackle two main challenges: the **low quality of pre-school educational services** and the **limited access of families**, especially in rural areas and for the most vulnerable groups.



EXPECTED RESULTS

1. Preschool teaching staff are **familiar with the Reggio Emilia approach** and are able to apply it;
2. The learning environments of the involved preschools are organized according to **a child-centered perspective**;
3. The new Educational Center for the Reuse of Materials, inspired by the REMIDA-Reggio Emilia experience, is **a public hub for promoting a culture of sustainability in schools**;
4. The National Council of Preschool Institutions of Kosovo (Collegium) has consolidated its position as **an effective forum for dialogue and the promotion of public-private partnerships** in early childhood services.
